3. What do you think grandma's response was to Reggie? Did she tell him that the Pink shirt symbolized a transgender snowman? A gay person or just someone who liked pink?
4. Lastly, why did Reggie feel the need to put a Bruins shirt on his snowman? Not many young African American boys play hockey - so was his t-shirt a protest symbol too!

Often when feeling uncomfortable - pre-teens and teens wear symbols on clothing or tattoos to express who they are and how they feel on issues, The campaign "I Love New York," was generated to renew pride in the city from a decaying city to one worthy of pride. Sports Pride is huge in Boston. The rivalry between both cities is passionate. This book seems timely.
